

ARCHAEOLOGICAL NOTE

It is considered worth placing on record the fact that the collections in the City Museum, Bristol, contain quantities of pottery allegedly from Lundy. These are as follows:-

- (1) Two parts of handles of Medieval jars, late 12th/early 13th Century AD. "Lundy" written on both sherds. Museum reference No. F.802.
- (2) Two dark grey Romano-British potsherds, both rims of cooking jars. Reference F.830.
- (3) Nineteen sherds of Samian ware, 1st and 2nd centuries AD, some of East Gaullish type. Ref. F.852 and one sherd Ref. F.1783 (renumbered from F.852). The surfaces of these sherds are in good condition and several show signs of repair by lead rivets.

It should be stressed that, particularly with the Samian ware, there is little evidence to prove that these items actually came from Lundy. The Museum Register shows F.852 as a Bronze Axe from Ireland whereas the paper with the pottery states "Lundy F.852". This is no reflection on the efficiency of the Bristol Museum, the items having been deposited some years ago and having survived the Blitz of the last war.

The condition and type of the Samian ware does suggest a provenance other than Lundy and it has been suggested that a misreading of "London" has occurred at some stage.

- (4) The sherd of Dark Age pottery referred to in my paper "Dark Age Remains on Lundy" included in this Report has been placed in the Bristol Museum on loan by Mr. R. Penwarden, in order that it may be available for study with the Giants Beads which are also housed there.

(5) To complete the collection a full plate photograph of the Tigernus Stone has been deposited with the beads and pottery.

I am indebted to the Director of the City Museum for permission to publish this note.
