

BUTTERFLIES IN 1980

Small White *Pieris rapae*. Recorded from 19th June to 16th August.

Peacock *Iachis io*. Record from 4th June to 9th August.

Red Admiral *Vanessa atalanta*. Recorded from 15th April in numbers reaching a peak of twenty two and the last five on 16th August.

Painted Lady *Vanessa cardui*. In small numbers from 15th April to 10th August.

Small Tortoiseshell *Aglais urticae*. Small numbers from 15th April to 15th August.

Fritillary species were seen from 3rd to 30th June.

Ringlet *Aphantopus*. Two on 10th June and one or two until 12th August.

Meadow Brown *Maniola jurtina*. The first one on 11th June and the last twenty on 16th August.

Small Copper *Lycaena phlaeas*. Recorded from 26th May to 16th August.

Common Blue *Polyommatus icarus*. Seen from 3rd June to 15th August, the last two.

Large White *Pieris brassicae*. Up to ten from 13th 15th August.

Emperor Moth *Saturnia pavonia*. One appeared on 16th April.

Magpie Moth *Abraxas grossulariata*. One on 16th April.

Green Tiger Beetle *Cicindela campestris*. One on 22nd June.

Killer Whale *Grampus orca*. One was seen on 1st August.
