*Acroricnus stylator (Thunb.) in June, 1983, females of this large ichneumon (which is parasitic on the wasp *Ancistrocerus oviventris*) were very common. One specimen was taken and sent to the British Museum where the identity was confirmed by Dr. M. Fitton. On 27.8.85, a male was taken at Angelica. Both specimens are in the British Museum collection. The species is very local.

Pycnocryptus director (Thunb.) common, west cliffs and Middle Park, May 1985

*Cidaphus atricillus (Haliday) a male and two females were taken in a small white light trap in Millcombe on the evenings of 27.8.85 and 28.8.85. This appears to be a rare species in Britain. All three specimens are in the British Museum collection, there being only eight previous specimens in that collection.

It is an extreme rarity, the only others known being the five specimens from which the species was described in 1953 (Perkins' type series in the British Museum)
